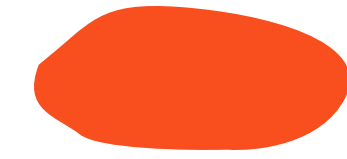

As a bootcamp graduate

100s of graduates per year, per bootcamp, per city

All knowing the same tech

So how do you stand out from the crowd?

Keep learning!

Check out the companies you want to join!

What are their tech stacks? What are they working on?

Build things!

Tech is fun! Having a theoretical knowledge of your stack doesn't achieve anything – build something goofy!

Show, don't tell.
